SURPRISE DROP



Some drops are unexpected and very disappointing!

The following charts show what may be an unexpected disappointing seasonal drop happening now.

The seasonal drop in the piece of gold and silver shares may be more than expected. The wave two decline just may equal the width of the triangle. A decline that large may surprise and disappoint seasonal expectations.
